Invite a Friend BACK to Church this Fall

How many people do you know that “used to go” to church but just don’t anymore? Probably quite a few. Most Americans have been to church and yet only about 20% are regular attendees, according to the book *American Church in Crisis* by David T. Olson. Many of these people, current research shows, are willing to try church again, given the right opportunity. Sometimes all it takes is an invitation from a friend or neighbor.

People stop attending church for a variety of reasons. Some of those reasons have little to do with a particular church and much to do with a belief that church in general is just not very important. Before engaging in a conversation with someone who has a hard time believing that one needs church, we need to be clear how to respond. Are you able to explain why church is not optional for a Christian?

Sadly, some people stop coming to church because of their experience at a particular church. Maybe no one spoke to them when they arrived. Perhaps the worship service itself failed to speak to their needs. It is possible that watching everyone leave with lunch plans left them feeling even lonelier than they were when they arrived. Before extending an invitation to someone to come and give church another try, we need to be certain that their negative experiences will not be repeated at our church. Are we able to promise the ones we invite a warm welcome and a meaningful time of worship?

What do you plan to do to insure that each person who enters FUMC receives a warm welcome?

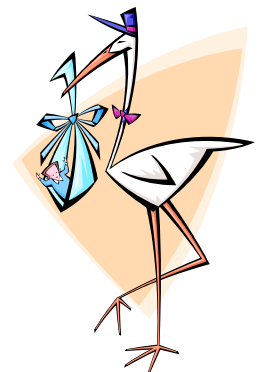


Welcome To the World
